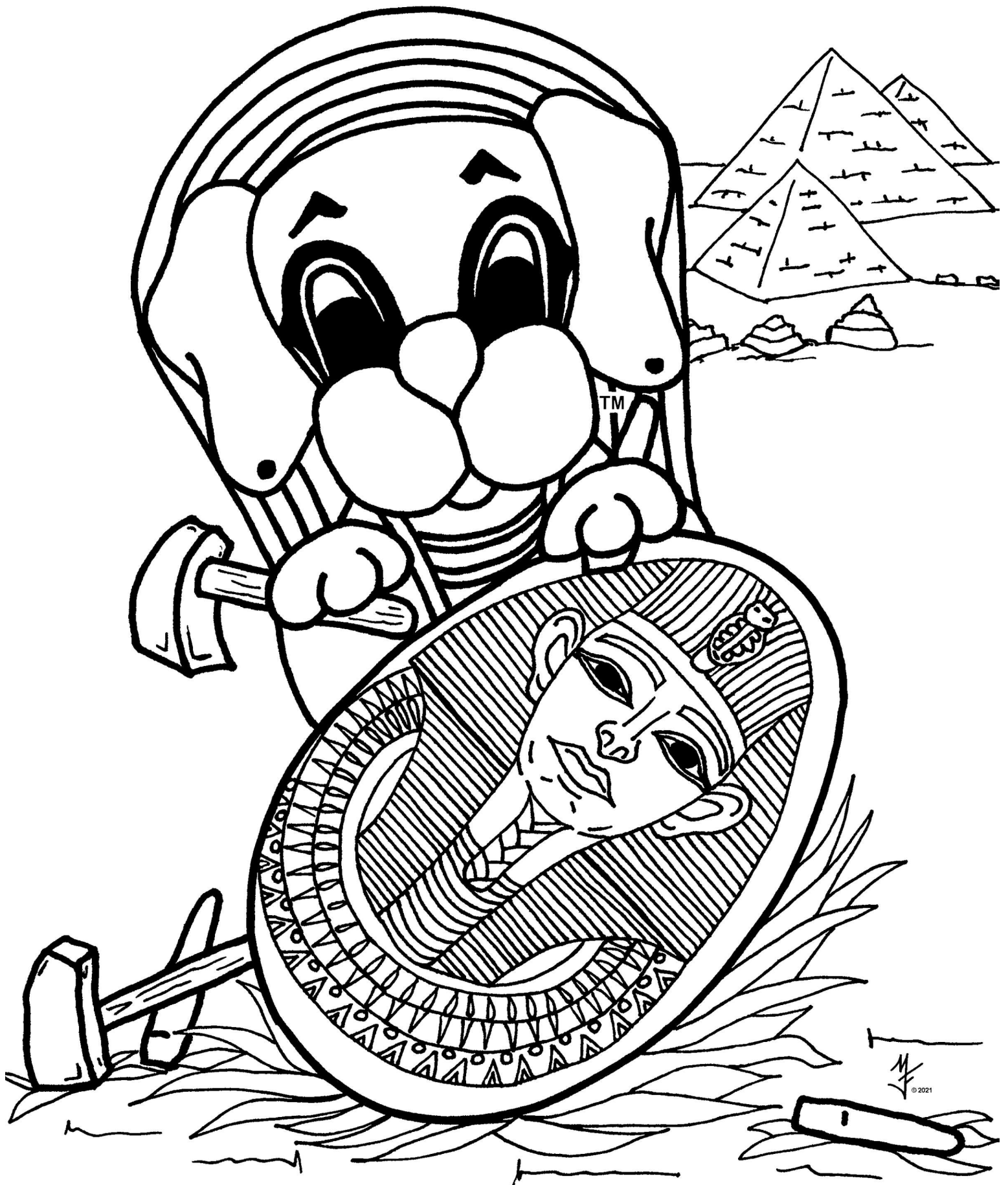












Dreamer Dog's Egyptian Egg Artistry

Can you walk like an Egyptian? Dreamer Dog studied Egyptian art and painted eggs in some of the best examples of Egyptian art. The ancient Egyptians celebrated both life and life after death. The walls of their tombs were an illustrated guide to survive the perils on the journey to the afterlife.

Khnum-Nakht (1985 to 1773 BCE) – Canopic chest of Nakht-Ankh, Tomb of the Two Brothers, Khnum-Nakht and Nakht-Ankh at Deir Rifa, Egypt. Middle Kingdom, 12th Dynasty. Painted wood. Manchester Museum, United Kingdom.

Amenhotep the Magnificent, or Amenhotep III (1386 to 1353 BCE) – The first Sun King, New Kingdom (9th Pharaoh of the 18th Dynasty). Colossal red granite statue (1370 BCE) Temple of Mut at Karnak. British Museum, London. Mud plaster floor painting Palace of Amenhotep III at Thebes (1390 to 1353 BCE). Waterfowl in lotus blossoms and aquatic plants in the naturalistic style.

Tutankhamen, King Tut (1333 to 1324 BCE) – New Kingdom, 18th Dynasty. ***Burial Chamber of King Tut.*** Tutankhamen is on the left in Amarna style kilt (clothing of the living), a wesekh collar, short wig with a gold band, a staff in his right hand, and a club with an Ankh (sign of the living) in his left hand. Center is Tut represented by Osiris wearing the Atef crown with gold plated uraeus and in each hand a nekhakha (whip or flagellum) which is a sign of power, and a wesekh collar. On the right is Ay performing the Opening of the Mouth Ceremony, usually reserved for the eldest son and affirms the legitimacy of the Pharaoh's heir. Ay represents the new Pharaoh and is carrying out the ceremony wearing a panther skin cloak of a sem priest and a blue crown with a uraeus in his hand. The Uraeus is an upright form of an Egyptian cobra and a symbol of royalty, deity, or divine authority. Sem priest is an embalmer who mummified the corpse and recited incantations while wrapping the mummy.

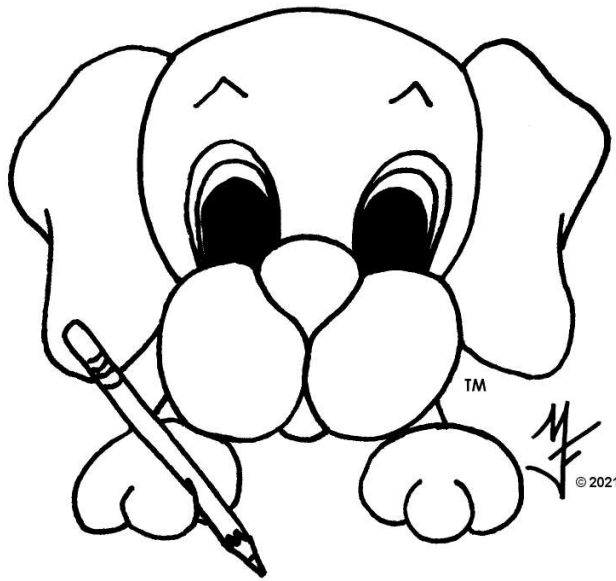
Nefertari (1279 to 1213 BCE) – 20th Dynasty. Wife of Ramses II. Her name means the Most Beautiful, Beloved of Mut. She wears a wig in the shape of a vulture's skin, topped with a feathered crown and solar disk. She was the first of 8 wives to Ramses II. Anubis, the Embalmer, as a black jackal crouched over a shrine with a nekhakha flail between his back paws, in the Tomb of the Queen. The walls have bright colors enhanced by a white background. Much of the decorations depict the Heliopolitan creation myth. The Valley of the Queens, Egypt.

Ramses II (1279 to 1213 BCE) – Pashedu Tomb, Servant in the Place of Truth, burial chamber. Ramesside Period, New Kingdom, 19th Dynasty (1295 to 1188 BCE). Deceased is drinking from a small basin under a large palm tree. The artisan lived in Deir el-Medina across from Thebes

and worked on the excavation and decoration of royal tombs during the reigns of Seti I and Ramses II.

Sarcophagus of an Egyptian Noblewoman (1070 to 767 BCE) – Third Intermediate Period, Libyans. Pasibkhanu or Pasebakhaenniut I (1047 to 1001 BCE), 3rd Pharaoh of the 21st Dynasty, ruler of Tanis. His name means the star appearing in the city. Burial or funerary mask. The Cairo Museum, Egypt.
