

Glass Cleaner



1/2 cup / 4 ounces 70% isopropyl rubbing alcohol
2 tablespoons / 1 ounce ammonia
2 to 4 drops grease cutting liquid dish detergent (Dawn)
Water

In a plastic spray bottle, combine rubbing alcohol, ammonia, and dish detergent. Add water to make 1 quart / 32 ounces. Screw on sprayer lid and shake bottle to mix ingredients.

Spray surface with a mist of glass cleaner. Use a small cloth or paper towel to clean glass. If using to frame art work or photos, clean both sides of glass prior to framing. Do not use glass cleaner on a plexi-glass surface.

Note: Glass cleaner works great to clean chrome bathroom fixtures in a hurry when company is coming. Spray fixtures and wipe off with a paper towel.
