

Spooky Flying Bats



Bats

- Stiffened felt sheet, 12 x 18 inch
- 1 1/2 inch pom poms
- 2 inch pom poms
- 1/4 inch glue on wiggly eyes
- Invisible fishing line, if desired

Supplies


- 1 cool glue gun
- Glue sticks

Trace pattern and cut bat from felt sheet. Fold in center. Open bat wings out. Glue one 1 1/2 inch pom pom for head in center of wings. The pom pom should be slightly past the edge of the wings. Attach one 2 inch pom pom for body below the head. Refold wings in center and hold to fully adhere pom poms while cooling.

Once cooled, glue on 2 wiggly eyes to head. Make sure the eyes show. Cure 24 hours before removing strings of excess glue. Store bats folded in half.

To display, fold wings along dotted lines. Thread fishing line through center back, if desired.

Note: You will get 3 bats from 1 sheet of felt. To easily trace pattern on black felt, use a white colored pencil. Be sure to cut inside the marked lines. Or, pin the pattern to the felt and cut. If you prefer larger bats, enlarge pattern and purchase materials in a larger size and quantity. Removing strings of glue before curing is complete may result in pulling the glued items apart.
