

Tie Dye Easter Eggs



- 12 hard cooked eggs, chilled
- 2 pairs old athletic socks
- 1 package egg decorating kit with 6 dye tablets
- 1/3 cup water per tablet
- 1 tablespoon white vinegar per tablet
- 1 eye dropper

Cover work space thickly with newspaper.

Cut off ribbed tops of athletic socks. Discard foot portion. Cut ribbed portion to lay flat. Dampen socks slightly.

In small bowls or ramekins, dissolve dye tablets in water and vinegar.

Stretch and wrap socks around eggs. Twist and hold sock around egg. Using the eye dropper, cover eggs with the various colors. Allow eggs to sit in sock for approximately 5 minutes on newspaper. Place dyed eggs back in carton to finish drying. Repeat for remaining eggs. Discard and recycle newspaper.

Cook's Note: Use a plastic apron and gloves to avoid damaging clothing. Rinse dye from socks and allow to dry, if saving to make additional eggs at a later time.
